




St Nick's, Allestree & St Paul's, Quarndon Newsletter

We have several weddings booked in across our four parishes in 2026. Each one is a wonderful opportunity to walk with those couples who want to say their vows before God.



Church weddings follow a pattern that invites us to reflect on what marriage is for and what it entails, before the couple make profound commitments to one another: committing to love one another through the darkest times as well as the most joyous – for richer for poorer, in sickness and in health etc till death do us part, before exchanging rings. At their conclusion I wrap my stole around their clasped hands – tying the knot – and declare:



‘Those whom God has joined let no one put asunder’.

It's a dramatic moment, actions adding weight to the words, emotions running high, everyone present erupting in celebration.

Knowing and worshipping God and sharing His love

All this ceremony and drama, for what? It all starts with love; our desire to love and be loved. I wonder how many of you gave or received Valentine's Day cards at school? How many longed for the person you had a crush on to send you a card? How many were brave enough to send one?! The agony and the ecstasy of those days seem so innocent and simple compared with today when so much happens online. We're so connected and yet studies seem to show that younger people are lonelier than ever and struggle to find their special someone IRL (in real life).



Humans are hardwired for connection, being in relationship with others. There is an African word, ubuntu, which captures this perfectly, it means 'I am because we are.' It means that an individual's existence and well-being are tied to the community, promoting compassion, respect, and interconnectedness over individualism.

Relationship is at the heart of the Gospel too. We believe in God who is somehow Father, Son and Holy Spirit. God's plan for humanity is to take us from the estrangement of Eden lost to reconciliation between created and loving creator. And the imagery of marriage mirrors what God intends for us, the final book of the Bible, Revelation, telling us that we are the bride, Jesus is our bridegroom. I think what God is saying to us is he wants to share with each of us a close personal relationship, that oneness of heart and mind that underpins a good marriage.






