How can I help?

There are different ways of helping, which range from a phone call to preparing a meal or assisting someone with their shopping.

Due to a need to ensure everyone is kept safe anyone wishing to become a part of the pastoral care team must complete the recommended safeguarding training and have undertaken a DBS check through the Diocese of Derby (see St Nick's safeguarding policy for more information).

Additionally, you will need to complete our GDPR consent form and provide two referees.

What?

Here at St Nick's our pastoral care usually falls into one of the following categories:

- Caring for the sick, elderly or the infirm
 - Visits to hospital or at home.
 - Assist in the provision of meals where necessary.
- Help to organise transport for medical or personal appointments.
- Arrange or accompany to medical or personal appointments as required.



- 2. Caring for church members
- Making a phone call or home visit when church member has not been seen or heard from in a few weeks.
- Look out for newcomers and encourage them to keep in touch.
- 3. Caring for the bereaved
- Phone the relatives of the newly bereaved a month and three months after a death.
- Follow up bereavement visits.
- Send a card on anniversaries if appropriate.
